- while the conceptual poster may include Title, Introduction/Background/Origin, Concept (along with not more than three tables/figures/diagrams/photographs) and bulleted Summary.
- It should be composed on a single sheet with appropriate colour scheme so that the content is readable from a distance of at least one meter; pasting of black and white A4 papers should be avoided.
