Weather Summary/Alert:

No rainfall is predicted on next 5 days. • Sky will be mainly clear to partly cloudy in next 5 days . • Wind speed will be 21-26 km/hr and the predominant wind direction will be Southerly to Southwesterly . • Maximum temperature is expected to be around 37.0-38.0 degree and minimum temperature is likely to be 29.0-30.0 degree. • Maximum and minimum relative humidity will be in the range of 81-89% and 40-65%

General Advisory:

As per extended range forecast normal rainfall is recorded from 18.5.23 to 31.5.23 . Based on MME forecast below normal rainfall is predicted from 2.6.23 to 15.6.23. Based on MME forecast Tmax will be above normal in Week 1 and 2. and for Tmin, it will show abovenormal in Week 1 and week 2. Heat Wave/Humid & discomfort weather likely to continue over the districts of West Bengal during 05 th–10 th June,2023 . Day temperature (Maximum temperature) is very likely to be above normal by 3-5 °C during 05 th –10 th June,2023. For avoiding heat stress enhance planting of trees nearby the field. To know the nowcast weather forecast for thunderstorm follow WhatsAppmessegas

SMS Advisory:

As no rainfall is predicted with high temperature and humidity, follow irrigation during afternoon hours in vegetable field and beetel vine garden and restrict grazing of cattle during mid day.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

BETELVINE	Green leaf stage Chital due to hot and humid weather • Apply Bordeaux mixture and keep proper aeration inside the garden during early morning hours for avoiding heat stress. • Apply sprinkler irrigation inside the garden during early morning hours.

Live Stock Specific Advisory:

Live Stock(Varieties)	Live Stock Specific Advisory
COW	At all stages • Worm infection due to hot and humid weather. • Feed the cattle at morning and evening time • Avoid mung mash and mustard cake in their food and supply arhar or black gram mash and sesame or linseed cake • Feed them enough amount of cool tap or tubewell water. • Keep the cattle indoor at afternoon hours also • Feed Bolus at 4 months interval@1 Bolus per 150kg body wt for worm infection. • Feed them a mixture of water (15liter)+molasses (250g)+basan (500g)+salt (50g) and sodium carbonate(50g) per cow during noon hours for avoiding heat stress. • Keep the adult cow and calf cool and fresh by bathing them one day interval.

Fisheries Specific Advisory:

CARP	All stages Low food intake due to hot weather • Feed the fishes during morning and afternoon hours • Make shadow by green pana (aquatic weed) at one side of pond • Uproot the weeds from the bottom of pond water for more oxygen supply
